Siegfried Tieber in the House!

We're in for a wonderful treat for our next meeting at 7:00 PM on November 8 back at our regular meeting place, OPICA at Stoner Park. The amazing Siegfried Tieber will be with us to explain and explore his approach to "Magic as Medium" - magic as a narrative art form used to communicate, share, and celebrate meaningful ideas. We will dissect Siegfried's approach, both method and presentation, to the Tantalizer, from Royal Road to Card Magic, as a way to illustrate certain ideas.

Siegfried Tieber is a Los Angeles-based performer and sleight-of-hand magician. Born and raised in Ecuador, his first international appearance was in 2011 in Bogotá, Colombia. In 2015, Siegfried headlined at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, the largest arts festival in the world, where his performance was highly praised by reviewers and critics. 2017 saw the premiere of his show See/Saw in Los Angeles and in 2018 the project was taken to New York, where Time Out NY listed it as #1 in its "The best magic shows in New York City." Siegfried has been featured in prominent media outlets such as Huffington Post, Los Angeles Times and Forbes. Most recently he was invited to be part of Penn & Teller: Fool Us, a television series featuring the legendary performance duo (yes, he did fool them).

Westside Wizards Perform Magic Show At Local Pumpkin Patch

The evening's performing theme was, fittingly, "Spooky Magic", and for the first half-hour club members discussed Assembly business and performed magic for one another as always—in this case, some of their most disturbing, creepy magic, with **Les Cooper**, **Brian Schwartz**, **Alexander Scianna**, **Cydney Kaplan**, and **Dan Cray** summoning the spirits.

But then they changed things up, inviting customers at the pumpkin patch to come watch club members perform an all-ages Halloween magic show, free of charge inside a mysterious black tent situated at the heart of the pumpkin stacks.

Christopher Cory went into action as show announcements blared over the loudspeakers, creating his renowned balloon animals for visitors arriving out front of the tent. Inside, **Jim Witoszynski** treated the packed house to a haunting edition of cups and balls; **Les Cooper** drove a wicked needle through the heart of a balloon that somehow survived to tell the tale, much to the relief of a child volunteer; **Phil Goodman** made cards behave in mysterious, and sometimes ghostly fashion; and Dan Cray helped a participant locate their missing dollar bill by carving into a randomly selected pumpkin and then allowing the participant to retrieve the bill from the gooey interior.

The successful show certainly added a magical new element to Shawn's Pumpkin Patch, which is one of the largest in Los Angeles and features a petting zoo, train, straw maze, hay bales, and carnival games, along with piles upon piles of every warty gourd and pumpkin imaginable. When you are ready to pay your Westside Wizards dues, set up a recipient in Zelle in the name of Les Cooper and phone number 310-621-8104.


Westside Wizards dues remain \$25 and \$5.00 for your spouse or partner.


