Paul has been awarded Lecturer and Close-Up Magician of the Year

from the AMA. Additionally, he has been nominated for Parlor Magician of the Year three times. He has published two sets of lecture notes, Take a Stroll With Me and Nothing Up My (Green)Sleeves. His DVD/downloads include The Classic Force and In the Trenches.

He has been married (to the same woman) for almost half a century! Paul has one daughter, Rebecca and one granddaughter, Scarlet.

STUNNING SLEIGHTS, BAR NONE Bar Magic Maestro Mike Pisciotta Wows Wizards at Nov. Lecture

It's not often you get to enjoy an instructional lecture from an Academy of Magical Arts Close-Up Magician of the Year, or for that matter an AMA Parlour Magician of the Year, but that's what happened when Assembly 291 welcomed Mike Pisciotta to their November meeting.

Pisciotta, a resident bar magician at the Magic Castle, has won each of those prestigious awards twice, and regularly inspires rapt audiences to cheer like they've just witnessed a second coming of Elvis. Would performing for a room of jaded magicians—in this case, the Westside Wizards—make any difference?

The short answer: not much. Pisciotta warmed up by presenting a smooth-as-butter coin routine where the sleight skills—which he methodically demonstrated subsequent to the performance—launched a night of audible, admiring gasps.

From there, Pisciotta treated everyone to "The Time Lord," where a chosen card "time-travels" by switching places with the ace of spades. A related effect, "Jokers Through Time," features a chosen card reappearing face-down amid four face-up jokers. The lecture also saw a chosen card magically appear between black aces, an innovative card-through-box routine, and a sleight-of-hand version of the classic rising card.



One of Pisciotta's showstoppers was the clever "Simple Evanescence," a no-palm, repeat card-to-wallet that incorporates a simple yet genius method. An alternate version had the memorable premise of Pisciotta discovering a torn-off card corner, with an accompanying ransom note demanding money to get the rest of the card back. His creative setup is rewarded by seeing the ransom payment transform into the restored card.

Pisciotta joked that he constructed the menacing-looking ransom note—a scary mishmash of glued-on alphabet letters—by going through magazines "and cutting them out, like a psychopath!"

The evening's finale, where a Chinese coin unexpectedly transforms into a quarter that appears in a volunteer's hand, carried the same title that the Westside Wizards later used to describe their entire evening with Mike Pisciotta: "Real Magic." – Dan Cray
